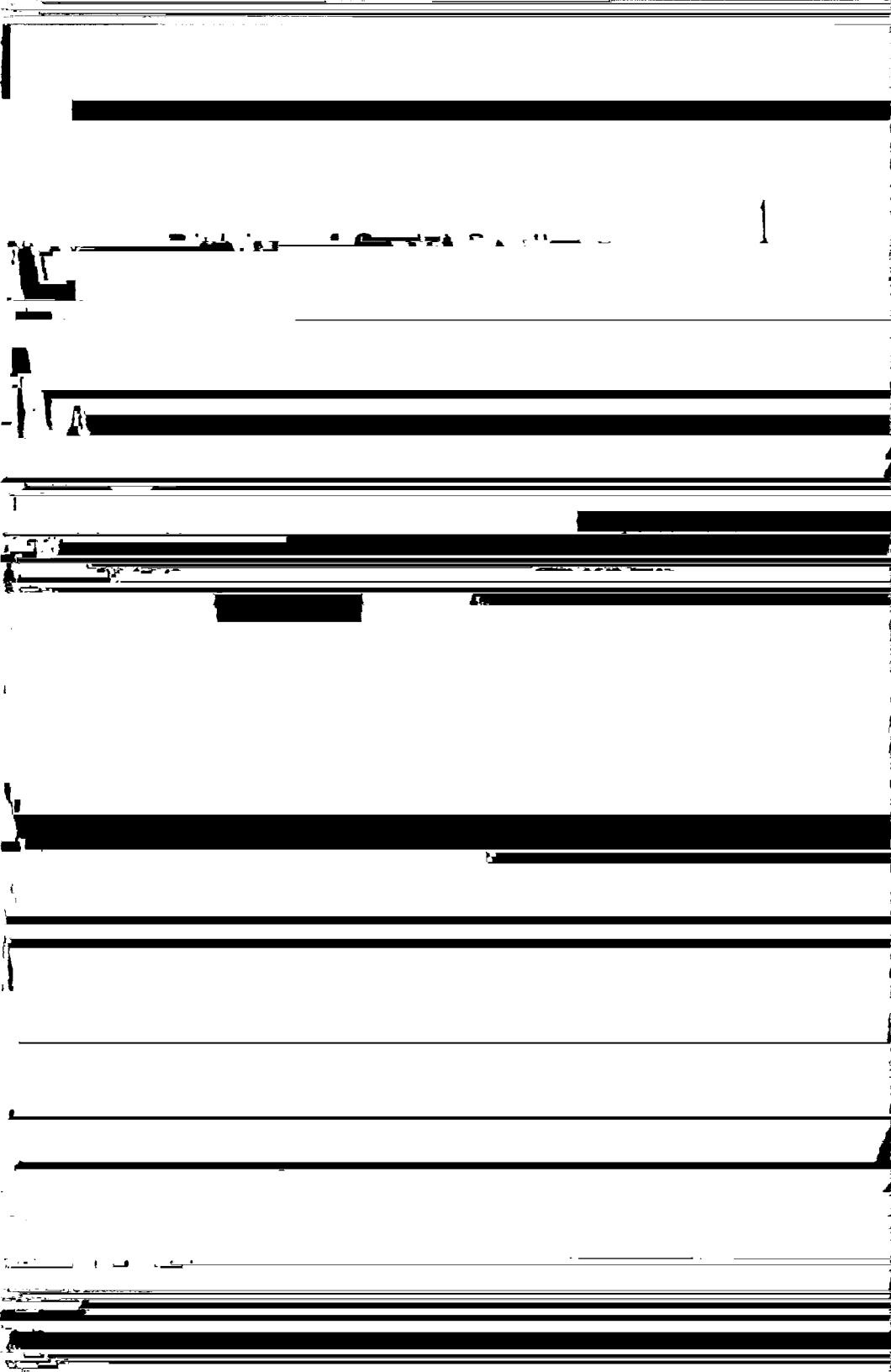
Following successful completion of courses prescribed for nurse

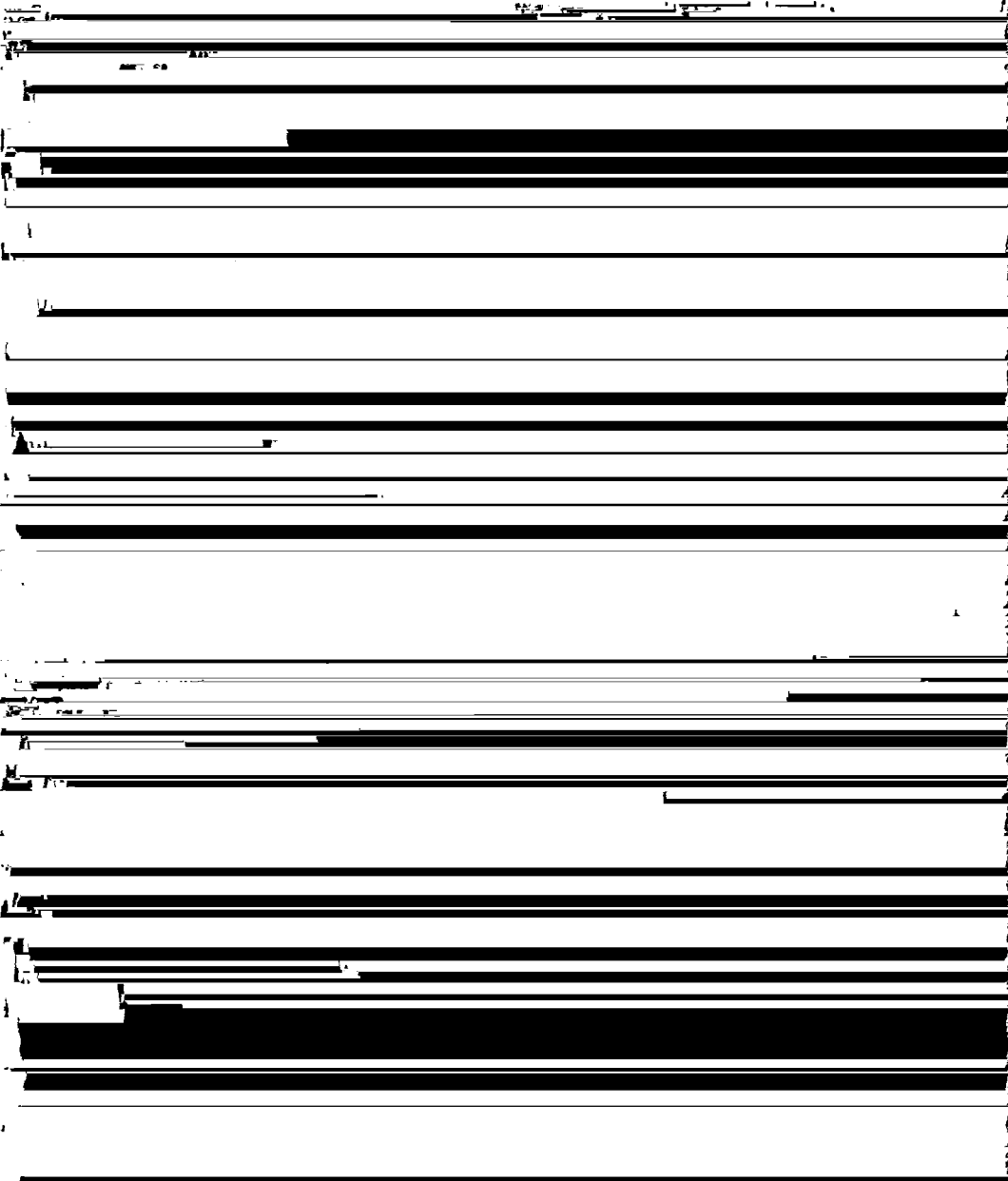

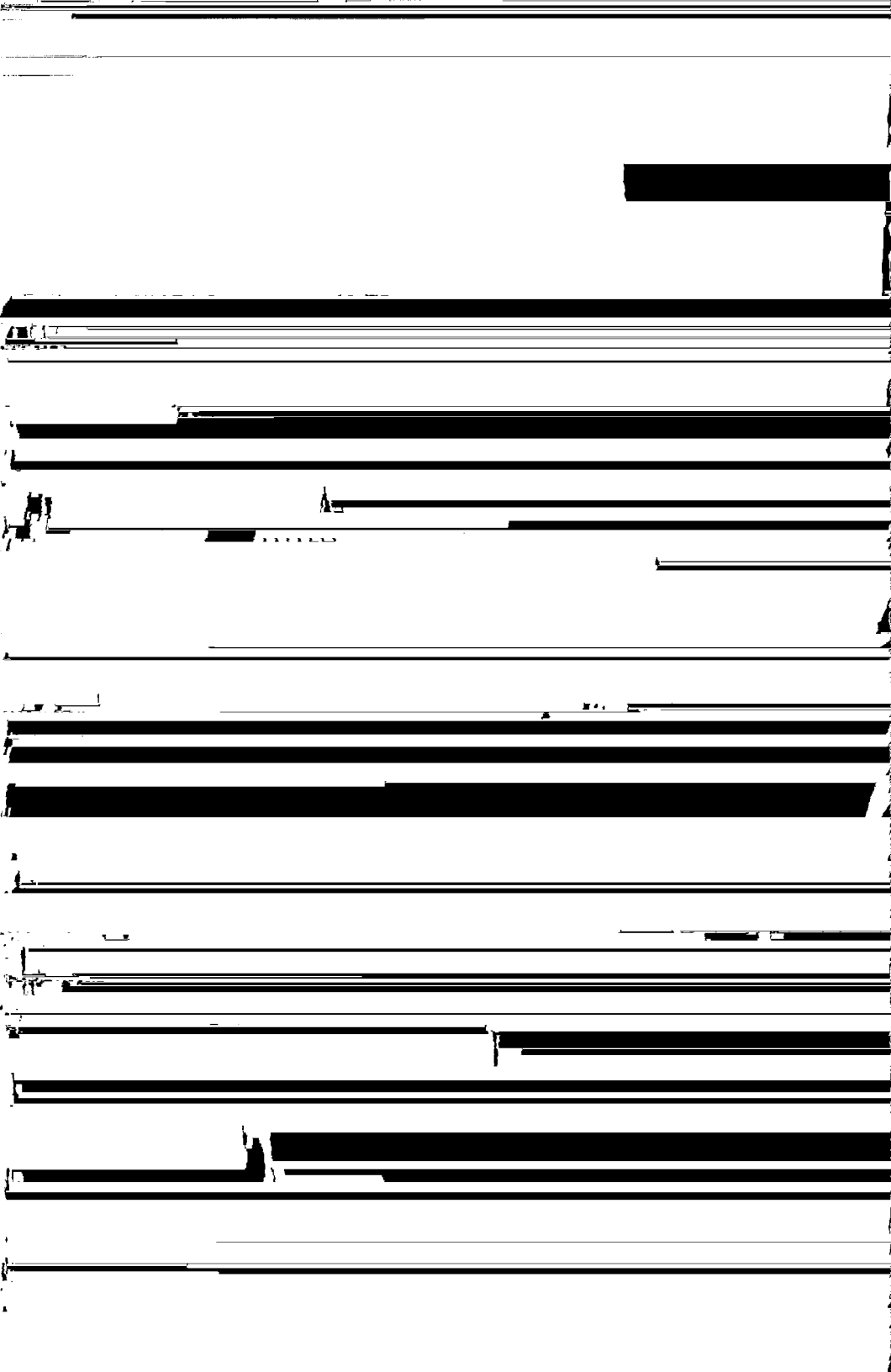
